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



# REFERENCES FOR ALUMINUM PLANKS

**TOOLS NEEDED:** pencil or marker and tape measure or ruler.



When attaching Seat / Seat Brackets and

Top "L" Brackets to Aluminum Planks.


#### **DRAWING REFERENCE LINES:**

Lay all 5 Planks side by side on a nonabrasive flat surface that will not damage the aluminum with the plank legs facing up as shown (bottom side up).

Draw a *Center Line* across all 5 Planks measuring equal distance from side edges. Then draw two *Lateral Lines* 28-1/2" parallel from *Center Line* on all boards (this will be your reference for bracket locations).

When attaching Center Bracket, Center Channel

and Center Spacer to Aluminum Planks.




# 6' AND 8' ALUMINUM PARK CHIEF ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


**TOOLS REQUIRED:** 9/16" wrench, 1/2" wrench and powered screw driver or drill with Phillips tip No. 2.

- 1.- Lay 3 Planks aligned side by side on a non-abrasive flat surface that will not damage the aluminum with legs facing up.
- 2.- Place 2 Top "L" Brackets aligned with the flat edge along the reference *Lateral Lines*. Attach each Bracket with 6 clips and 1" carriage bolts mounted in Plank's side channels as shown. Hand fasten nuts. (see page 2 for clip locations).
- 3.- Insert 1-1/4" carriage bolt through clip and place in Plank's center channel aligned with the *Center Line*. While holding the clip/bolt, place Center Spacer, Center Channel and Center Bracket as shown. Hand fasten nut. (see page 2 for clip locations).
- 4.- Align parts assembled in step 4 to *Center Line* and attach Center Channel's outer holes to side planks using mounting clips and 1" bolts. Hand fasten nuts. (see page 2 for clip locations).

5.- Verify Center Spacer alignment. Then use clip and 1" carriage bolt mounted in center Plank's center channel to attach Center Spacer's side hole. (see page 2 for clip locations).

6.- Make sure Planks and Brackets are aligned. Then tighten all 16 nuts.






Note: Do not fully tighten any of the nuts from steps 8-10 until step 16 below.


10.- Attach loose end of Brace to Center Bracket mid range holes using 1" bolts / nuts.

9.- Attach Leg set to inside Top "L" Bracket. Use 2-3/4" bolts / nuts.



surface that will not damage the aluminum with legs facing up. 12.- Align Seat Bracket's flat edge to Plank's *Lateral Lines* as shown. Attach using clips and 1" carriage bolts mounted in side channels. Tighten firmly.

13.- Attach Seat End Caps using 3/4" self-drilling screws.



- 14.- Flip the partial table assembly into an upright position.
- 15.- Attach Seats to Frame with table legs inside Seat Brackets as shown. Use 2-3/4" bolts / nuts.
- 16.- Tighten all nuts firmly, including assembled parts in steps 8, 9 and 10.
- 17.- The Picnic Table is finished.

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
